

SapNaz Kids Operations Plan | Color Codes

The Oklahoma State Board of Education has recommended a color-coding system that follows the Oklahoma State Department of Health COVID-19 Alert System. These weekly reports reflect a county's risk based on cases per 100,000 people and provide guidance depending on the current level of risk.

SapNaz Kids will follow Sapulpa Public Schools' system and color based on the days/week prior to the Sunday in which we're meeting. Wearing masks is strongly recommended.

Green is the lowest zone (fewer than 1.43 cases per 100,000 people). In Green, COVID-19 positive cases are presently at a manageable level. There are general guidelines to follow, but children's ministry will meet in the new normal (Sundays & Wednesdays)

Yellow is the caution zone (1.43 to 14.38 cases per 100,000). In yellow, children's ministry will meet, phasing the various aspects of ministry, beginning with children's church then Sunday School and finally with Wednesday nights. Masks are strongly encouraged from yellow to red.

Orange Level (14.38 to 49.99 cases per 100,000). In orange, children's ministry will continue to host family events that meet outside or in large rooms where social distancing is in place. The nursery will remain open. Other Sunday and Wednesday kid-specific ministry will not take place.

Red Level (50+ cases per 100,000). In red, we will not physically gather as a congregation & in-person gatherings for SapNaz Kids will not be offered. Online opportunities will be provided.
